- b) What is a dramatic monologue? Critically analyze Robert Browning’s use of the dramatic monologue device as an essential instrument in examining the human mind. Discuss with close reference to “Fra Lippo Lippi”. 5+10=15

2. a) How does Shaw’s portrayal of Vivie in *Mrs. Warren’s Profession* exemplify the feminist ideal of the “New Woman”? Answer with reference to the text. 15

- b) Critically analyze Shaw’s *Mrs. Warren’s Profession* as an anti-sentimental play. 15

3. a) Attempt a reading of the character of Heathcliff as a villain-hero. 15

- b) How does the natural world of the moors influence the characters and setting in *Wuthering Heights*? 15

4. a) Would you agree with Lionel Trilling’s view that the title *Culture and Anarchy* may be substituted by ‘Culture or Anarchy’? Substantiate your argument with apt references from the text. 15

**OR**

- b) Who are the Barbarians, Philistines and Populace according to Arnold? Examine the distinctive features of each class of people as observed by the author in *Culture and Anarchy*. 5+10=15
