The Department of History had organised an outreach programme in Barua Village for pollution consciousness among the villagers. The participants worked to spread awareness to remove plastic because plastic pollutes water and soil. The inhabitants were made conscious about water contamination and sound pollution. Smoke pollution was also discussed. The participants made them conscious about air pollution and about different type of diseases, such as Cholera, Diarrhoea, Malaria etc.
