7.3.1. Portray the performance of the Institution in one area distinctive to its priority and thrust within 200 words

Since its inception, Sewnarayan Rameshwar Fatepuria College has developed a distinctive mission with a focus on a humanitarian face to aid Yaas Cyclone victimised people at Sundarban through its mission, values and way of life. The College provided the Community Kitchen in the village Jota Narendrapur, Raidighi Block, Godkhali, Bali Island and Kumimari Island, South 24 Parganas. It is run and managed by local inhabitants. The college has tried heart and soul efforts to relieve grief-stricken victims of Sundarban due to the Cyclonic effect by providing food help.

Very severe cyclonic storm Yaas brought disastrous impact in 24 Parganas of West Bengal during late May 2021. Because of excessive rainfall during the effect, a lot of people came into a dire disaster of losing homes and searching for food. The people were wretched in condition and haunt about in search of food. The Institution in the critical moment of the life of the people of Sundarban, feel pain and is eager to provide as much help as it can and to fulfil the purpose arrange a community kitchen in the said area on the 7th, 8th and 9th June 2021. Though the aid was little in respect of dire disaster; the effort was full.

Sewnarayan Rameshwar Fatepuria College has been pursuing its mission and executing its strategy of value education with apparent success and it is in the process of leveraging its entrepreneurial drive further with ongoing expansion in terms of value and humanistic education.
