## STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY (SSS): 2020-21

The survey was conducted in the month of February, 2021 among the $1^{\text {st }}$ Semester, 3rd Semester, $5^{\text {th }}$ Semester students of this college. The questions in the questionnaire were mixture of 5-point Likert scale questions, dichotomous questions and one open-ended question. It was optional for the students to participate in the survey. As a result of Covid related lockdown only 245 students responded and among them, 144 were girls.

$59 \%$ of the respondents were girls and around $41 \%$ were boys.

1. Is the teaching and mentoring that takes place in the college useful?


78\% of the students reported that teaching and mentoring were significantly helpful and 20\% of the students reported they were very well helpful.
2. Are the Course and Programme Outcomes Explained to the Students?

All the responding students (100\%) reported that course outcomes and programme outcomes were explained to them by the teachers every time.
3. Are the assessment criteria for the courses explained to you at the beginning of the semester/academic year?

94\% of the responding students reported that the assessment criteria explained to them every time and remaining $6 \%$ of the respondents reported that they are usually explained the assessment criteria by the teachers.

Regarding the effectiveness of the faculty in communicating the content of the course, $96 \%$ of the respondents reported that they were very effective and the remaining $4 \%$ of the respondents reported somewhat effective.
5. How effective are the teachers in teaching new and challenging topics?


Regarding effectiveness of the teachers in teaching new and challenging topics, $68 \%$ of the respondents reported that teachers are very effective in teaching new and challenging topics, $25 \%$ reported that they are somewhat effective and remaining $7 \%$ reported that teachers were just effective in this area.
6. Do teachers use examples and applications to explain concepts in order to make the course interesting and relevant?


Regarding the use by teachers of examples and applications to explain concepts in order to make the course interesting and relevant, $90 \%$ responded with every time, and remaining $10 \%$ reported with usually teachers use examples and application for the purpose.
7. How well do you think the faculties prepare for the classes?


Regarding how faculties prepare for the classes, $86 \%$ reported that faculties were thoroughly prepared for the classes and remaining $14 \%$ reported that they were satisfactorily prepared for the classes.
8. Are student-centric methods, like participative learning and problem-solving methods used for enhancing the learning process?


Regarding whether the student-centric methods, like participative learning and problem-solving methods used for enhancing the learning process, $78 \%$ of the students reported that students' centric methods were used by the teachers to a great extent to enhance the learning process and the remaining $22 \%$ reported that moderately students' centric methods were used.
9. Do teachers make an effort to identify your weaknesses and help you overcome them?


Regarding efforts of the teachers to identify the weaknesses of students and help overcome them, 65\% reported that every time efforts were made and remaining $31 \%$ reported that usually efforts were made and $04 \%$ reported that occasionally efforts were made by the teachers.
10. Do the teachers check on you with regard to your academic and co-curricular responsibilities?


Whether teachers check on students with regard to academic and co-curricular responsibilities, 18\% reported that they did it every time, 23\% reported that they did it usually and the remaining 59\% reported that they did it occasionally.

Whether teachers open for academic guidance after class, 78\% of the respondents reported that every time teachers were open, $14 \%$ reported that teachers were usually open and remaining $8 \%$ reported that occasionally/sometimes teachers were open for academic guidance after class.
12. Does the faculty make an attempt to identify your strengths and encourage you by providing suitable challenges?


Regarding attempts of the faculty to identify strengths of students and encourage them by providing suitable challenges, $80 \%$ of the respondents reported fully and the remaining $20 \%$ reported reasonably attempts were made.

Regarding fairness in the evaluation of the internal examinations/assignments/tutorials, $84 \%$ reported always fair and remaining $16 \%$ reported usually fair.
14. Are assignments/tutorials returned within a reasonable period of time?

$81 \%$ of the respondents reported with every time and remaining $19 \%$ reported with usually.
15. Are the results of internal exams/test available online one month within the completion of the examination?

All the students responded with rarely.

All the students responded with every time.
17. Do you feel the need for remedial teaching?


Whether students feel the need for remedial teaching, $17 \%$ of the students feel every time, $77 \%$ reported that they feel usually and $6 \%$ of the students feel Occasionally/Sometimes.
18. What percent of teachers use ICT tools like LCD projector etc while teaching?

All the respondents reported that between $\mathbf{5 0}$ to $\mathbf{6 9 \%}$ of the teachers use various ICT tools for teaching. Here use of microphone is also considered as ICT tools.
19. Do the teachers treat you with respect?

All the students reported that they were treated with respect.
