


STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY (SSS): 2023-2024

1.The survey was conducted in the month of February, 2024 among the 1st Semester, 3rd Semester, 5th Semester students of this college. The questions in the questionnaire were mixture of 5-point Likert scale questions, dichotomous questions and one open-ended question. It was optional for the students to participate in the survey. Only 167 students responded and among them, 96 were girls.



57% of the respondents were girls and around 43% were boys.

2.Is teaching and monitoring that takes place in the college useful?




51% of the students reported that teaching and mentoring were **significantly useful** and 46% of the students reported that they were **very well** helpful. Remaining 3% responded they were moderately.

3.Are the courses outcomes and programme outcomes explained to you by the faculty?


All the responding students (100%) reported that the courses outcomes and programme outcomes were **fully** explained to them by the faculty members every time.

4.Are the assessment criteria for the courses explained to you at the beginning of the semester?




86% of the responding students reported that the assessment criteria were explained to them by the teachers **every time** and the remaining 14% reported that it was done **usually**.

5. How effective is the faculty in communicating the content of the courses when they teach?




Regarding the effectiveness of the faculty in communicating the content of the courses ,95% of the responding students reported that teachers are **very effective** in communicating the content of the courses and the remaining 5% reported that they are **somewhat effective** in this area.

6. How effective are the teachers in teaching new and challenging topics?





7. Do teachers use examples and applications to explain concepts in order to make the course interesting and relevant?





8. How well do you think the faculty prepare for the classes?




96% of the responding students reported that the teachers take the classes being **thoroughly** prepared and the remaining 4% reported that the teachers were **satisfactorily** prepared.

9. Are the student-centric methods like participating and problem-solving methods used for enhancing the learning process?




Regarding whether the student-centric methods, like participative learning and problem-solving methods are used for enhancing the learning process, 79% of the students reported that students' centric methods were used by the teachers to a great extent while 17% of the students reported that they were used **moderately** and the remaining 4% reported with **somewhat**.

10. Do teachers make an effort to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them?




Regarding efforts of the teachers to identify the weaknesses of students and help to overcome them, 60% of the respondents reported that the teachers make efforts to identify their weakness and help them to overcome it **everytime**,34% of them reported that teaches do this **usually** and the remaining 6% reported with **occasionally**.

11.Do the teachers check on you with regards to your academic and co-curricular responsibilities?





12. Are the teachers available for the academic guidance after class?





13. Does the faculty make an attempt to identify your strengths and encourage you by providing suitable challenges?





Whether the assignments are returned within a reasonable period of time,89% of the respondents reported that it is done **everytime**,9% reported with **usually** and the remaining 2% reported with **occasionally**.


16. Are the results of the internal examinations available online within one month of the completion of the examinations?

All the respondents (100%) reported with rarely.

17. Are the teachers willing to discuss the assignments/exam question papers and answer script with you?

Out of 167 respondents,157 reported that the teachers are willing to discuss the question papers with the answer scripts **everytime**,8 of them reported with **usually** and the remaining 2 reported with **occasionally**.

18.Do you feel the need of remedial teaching?



Whether students feel the need for remedial teaching, 41% of the students feel **every time**, 43% reported that they feel **usually** and 16% of the students feel **Occasionally/Sometimes**.


19. What percent of teachers use ICT tools like LCD projector etc while teaching?

21. How would you rate the quality of the teaching-learning process in the college?



22. Are you offered add-on/enrichment courses to provide you greater opportunities for learning and growth?



23. Are you given the opportunity to go on field visits as and when needed?





When asked about whether students are encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities, 87% reported **affirmative** and 13% reported **negative**.


26. Does the college engage in imparting soft skills?

27. Does the college impart employability skills?



28. Considering the constraints of space and topography in the college, are you satisfied with the sports facilities provided to you?




